Taça monocroma azul

China, Dinastia Qing, período Daoguang (1821-1850)

Em porcelana com vidrado ji lan (azul sacrificial) de tom profundo e uniforme

De forma circular com paredes arqueadas sobre pé anelar

Com lábio de rebordo fino evidenciando a característica linha branca por escorrimento natural do vidrado

A base revestida de vidrado branco

Base com marca de seis caracteres do período Daoguang, em escrita de selo, a azul sob vidrado

A sacrificial-blue monochrome bowl

China, Qing Dynasty, Daoguang period (1821-1850)

Of porcelain, covered in a deep and even ji lan (sacrificial-blue) glaze

Of circular form with rounded sides rising from a straight foot ring

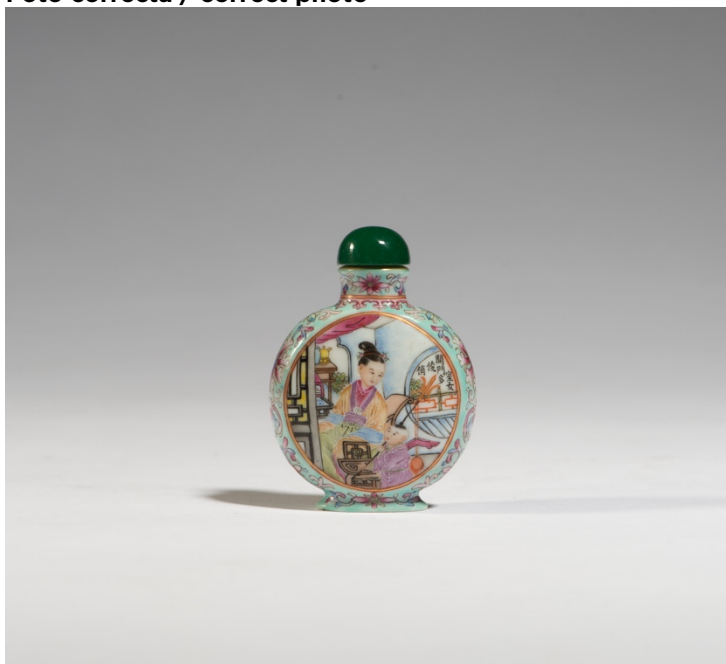
With a thin rim revealing the characteristic white line from the natural pooling of the glaze

The base covered in a white glaze

Bearing a Daoguang six-character seal mark in underglaze blue to the base
